

## Shot Requirements for 2017-2018 School Year

Due by September 1<sup>st</sup> 2017

**EXEMPTION APPLICATIONS** must be renewed **EVERY YEAR** with the Department of Health and have to be given to the nurse at the start of every school year. **\*\*Exemptions are only approved by the Department of Health and not a regular physician\*\*** see below

<b>DTAP</b>	4 doses
<b>Tdap</b>	Age 11
<b>Polio</b>	3-4 doses
<b>MMR</b>	2 doses
<b>Hep B</b>	3 doses
<b>MCV4 (Meningococcal)</b>	1 <sup>st</sup> dose given at age 11 with Tdap vaccine or by 7 <sup>th</sup> grade 2 <sup>nd</sup> dose at age 16
<b>Varicella</b>	2 doses
<b>Hep A</b>	1 <sup>st</sup> dose by kindergarten 2 <sup>nd</sup> dose by 1 <sup>st</sup> grade

### Exemptions:

Only a letter issued by the Medical Director, Immunization Section of the Arkansas Department of Health, stating the vaccine or vaccines for which a child/student is exempt is to be accepted as a valid medical exemption by the school. Statements from private physicians are not to be accepted by the school without this letter. In addition to the general requirements found in section 5.01, the Immunization Section's standard form for medical exemptions must be submitted to the Immunization Section. This form is available from the Immunization Section of the Department of Health upon request.
